MINUTES OF THE CUSTER CO. BOARD OF SUPERVISOR

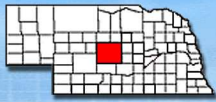
August 13, 2019

Motion by Olson, 2nd Kleeb, to approve the monthly fee reports for July for the Co. Clerk, Reg of Deeds, Clerk Dist. Court, Co. Sheriff, and Recycling. Roll call vote. Ayes-all

J Callaway, Rod Pracht, representatives for the Broken Bow Airport, presented and reviewed a financial report. Motion by Bryner, 2nd Kleeb, to approve the Interlocal Agreement for FY2019-20 with Broken Bow Airport Authority, for \$13,000.00. Roll call vote. Ayes-all

Sargent Airport also presented their Interlocal. Motion by Myers, 2nd Stunkel, to approve the Interlocal Agreement for FY2019-20 with Sargent Airport Authority, for \$2500.00. Roll call vote. Ayes-all

M. Nelson, CC Fairgrounds reported on the Mid State Rodeo Association's finals coming to town. Motion by Bryner, 2nd Myers, to approve an SDL for the Custer Co Ag Society for the MSRA Finals, Sept 12-15th, 2019. Roll call vote. Ayes-all

T. Schauda and Kent Nelson from the Fair Board reported on the activities and plans for the next year, and request their budget amount for FY19-20, \$173400.00.

Salary discussion was brought up for clerical and appointed officials. After much discussion a motion was made. Motion by Stunkel, 2nd Myers, to recommend a 2 ½% increase, retro to July 1st. Roll call vote. Ayes-all

C. Jacobsen presented an application:

Motion by Olson, 2nd Eggleston, to approve an application for Great Plains Communications, to go under co road with fiber optic cable, Sand Valley. S4-15-25. Roll call vote. Ayes-all

Chairman Fox, read the Hwy Dept's road study on Road #631. Motion by Eggleston, 2nd Bryner, to approve Res.#25R-2019, to accept the road study and set the hearing date for Sept 20, 2019, on Road #631. Roll call vote. Ayes-all

Supervisor Eggleston brought up the issue on the township loans that are available thru Custer County. It had been decided to keep these loans open.

Supervisor Stunkel, brought up the issue of illegal immigration and wanting the County to be prepared to not have illegals in Custer County. C. Attorney Bowers advised that there is a policy in place to handle these situations and that he would review to see if it would be for Custer County. Motion was made by Stunkel and motion was withdrawn by Stunkel. Co. Attorney Bowers was directed to research.



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Motion by Myers, 2nd Bryner, to adjourn as the Co. Board and convene as the **Board of Equalization at 11:15 a.m.** Roll call vote. Ayes-all Nays-none

Motion by Olson, 2nd Eggleston, to approve Res. #23-2019, to approve an additional one percent increase to the base amount for restricted funds authority, making a total of three and one-half percent in the restricted funds authority for FY2019-2020. Roll call vote. Ayes-all

Motion by Bryner, 2nd Myers, to recess as the **Board of Equalization** and reconvene as the Co. Board at 11:18 a.m. Roll call vote. Ayes-all

Fox made a short report on the renovation project.
