October 15, 2019

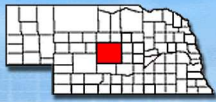

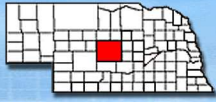

Clerk Gracey spoke on Myrtle Townships Budget being different from allocation request. Motion by Stunkel, 2nd Bryner, to approve the \$800.00 increase for allocation for Myrtle Township for FY19-20. Roll call vote. Ayes-all

The BOE reviewed the Levies as presented by the Custer County Clerk Gracey. Motion by Bryner, 2nd Eggleston, to approve Res. #33-2019, to set the levies as presented(Attachment A) for all political subdivisions for FY2019-2020, for Custer County. Roll call vote. Ayes-all

Motion by Bryner, 2nd Kleeb, to recess as the **Board of Equalization** and reconvene as the Co. Board at 9:40 a.m. Roll call vote. Ayes-all

Last meeting the Co. Board directed the Co. Attorney to draw up a resolution for inventory sheets. Motion by Olson, 2nd Kleeb, to approve Res. #34-2019, to set the Inventory Dollar Limit at \$250.00, either as a single item or an aggregate items to be omitted from all County Offices inventory's. Roll call vote. Ayes-all

Motion by Kleeb, 2nd Stunkel, to approve the September monthly fee reports for the Clerk, Reg of Deeds, Clerk Dist Court, Sheriff, and Recycling. Roll call vote. Ayes-all

S. Bowers, Co. Attorney spoke on the Opioid issue in Nebraska and that the State never joined, so it's up to each County. Motion by Kleeb, 2nd Bryner, to have Custer County remain a Class Member in this Opioid negotiation class. A motion by Kleeb, 2nd Stunkel, to direct the Co. Attorney to write a letter for the Co. Board to sign and send on their opioid concerns. Roll call vote. Ayes-all

Darrel Stanard, Appraiser, and L. Lymber, Co. Assessor reviewed the process of determining the valuations. Many good questions were asked by the Co. Board and answered by Stanard. A better understanding of the whole process was reached.

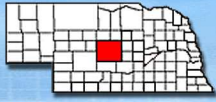

Three bids were opened – Ranchland Ford, Gateway Motors, Sandhills Motors.
Motion by Kleeb, 2nd Olson, to take bids under advisement and have the Sheriff review, tabulate and come back with a recommendation. Roll call vote. Ayes-all
Dep. Sheriff Miller came back with a recommendation on the pickups. Motion by Olson, 2nd Stunkel, to award the Bids for the Co. Sheriff Vehicles – for a 2019 Dodge w/trade in of a 2014 Dodge Ram to Sandhills Motors, Arnold- \$19,900.00: for a 2020 Chevrolet from Gateway Motors, BB - \$35,194.00. Roll call vote. Ayes-all

C. Jacobsen, presented one application:
Motion by Stunkel, 2nd Bryner, to approve an application for NE Central Telephone Co, for fiber optic cable, Dr, 448, 4.5 miles SW of Ansley. Roll call vote. Ayes-all

Custer Township Board – J. Wiese and R. Maxwell wanted to discuss two issues with the Co. Board. Grading of two roads and inspection on a bridge, the County Supervisor for that area will meet with them and get back to the Board.

K. Olson, Smoken Hot Steakhouse requested a SDL. Motion by Bryner, 2nd Stunkel, to approve a Special Designated License for K. Olson, Smoken Hot Steakhouse for November 9th at the Paddock building at the Fairgrounds for the Aubree's Angels Fund Raiser. Roll call vote. Ayes-all

Megan Jackson- Nebraska Recycling Council, reported on exports that will not be any longer, investors starting to get manufacturing here, and very optimistic that recycling will come back strong – maybe 3-5 years. Custer County has one of the strongest and most resilient programs. .
