MINUTES OF THE CUSTER CO. BOARD OF SUPERVISOR

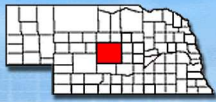
January 28, 2020

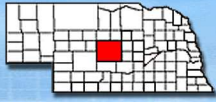
Andrew Ambriz, CED, reviewed the CDBG program report. Motion by Stunkel, 2nd Eggleston, to accept the Economic Dev. Revolving Loan Funds report as presented by Andrew Ambriz for period ending Dec. 31, 2019. Roll call vote. Ayes-all

Ambriz reported to the Co. Board that the State and HUD are looking for idle funds and Custer County's will need to be returned by June 30, 2020. Several options to repurpose these funds are being considered and he will get back to the Co. Board.

C. Jacobsen, Hwy Dept. discussed load limit signs.

Motion by Bryner, 2nd Eggleston, to approve Res. #6R-2020, to grant permits to individuals or entities to exceed only the load limit restrictions place on said road.

Chris Reed from Anderson Elevator visited with the Co. Board about the road, the Anselmo railroad crossing and the estimate as presented to finish. Since this started in 2012, it's the closest we have all been on making this a safe crossing. Anderson Elevator will get back to us in a week about funding and we can proceed.

Tobin Buchanan-First National Capital Markets, Kearney – introduced and reviewed the Judicial Center bond and options for Custer County.
