Chairman Fox read and reviewed the political subdivisions requests for FY2020-21. Arnold Township was over their allocation and will need to be adjusted. It was discussed that the other entities that request support for the year were being set as the same as last year, after much discussion the Ag Society is to remain the same as last year too.

Motion by Olson, 2nd Stunkel, to approve Res. #39-2020 to set the Preliminary Levy Allocation Requests for FY2020-21 as requested, except with the changes to the Custer Co Ag Society allocation request from \$179,512.00 to same as last year at \$173,400.00; and Arnold Township from the requested \$295,550.00 to \$257,165.00; and set the MFO at 0.015000. Roll call vote. Ayes-all

Motion by Kleeb, 2nd Stunkel, to approve the CC Historical Society-\$8500.00; Seven Valleys Historical Society-\$6000.00; CHORE-\$5000.00; no increase from last year's asking. Roll call vote. Ayes-all

Motion by Kleeb, 2nd Stunkel, to close the Public Hearing. Roll call vote. Ayes-all

Motion by Olson, 2nd Eggleston, to offer to relinquish said Road #947 to Elim Township. Roll call vote. Ayes-all

Motion by Olson, 2nd Eggleston, to open a Public Hearing at 10:20 a.m. on the Petition #3417 to vacate all of Road #1143. Roll call vote. Ayes-all

Glen Miller stated no objections.

Motion by Stunkel, 2nd Kleeb, to close the Public Hearing. Roll call vote. Ayes-all

Motion by Olson, 2nd Eggleston, to offer to relinquish said Road #1143 to Elim Township. Roll call vote. Ayes-all

Motion by Myers, 2nd Bryner, to approve closing the Arnold-Dunning Road, and Callaway-Cozad Road for next year's SORC on August 13-15, 2021. Roll call vote. Ayes-all Abstain-Olson

Motion by Bryner, 2nd Kleeb, to table the 5-year sprinkler agreement. Roll call vote. Ayes-all

Chairman Fox read the Res. #40R-2020. Motion by Eggleston, 2nd Bryner, to approve Res. #40R-2020, to declare Vacated that part of Road #818, Petition #3412. Roll call vote. Ayes-all Nays-Stunkel

Chairman Fox read the Res. #41R-2020. Motion by Eggleston, 2nd Bryner, to declare Vacated that part of Road #44, Petition #3413. Roll call vote. Ayes-all Nays-Stunkel

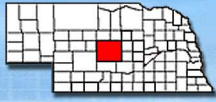
Chairman Fox reported on the Mason City railroad crossing that BNSF would like to close. Motion by Stunkel, 2nd Olson, to direct the Co. Hwy Supt to complete a Road Study on Road #325 ½, and Mason City railroad crossing. Roll call vote. Ayes-all

In February it was a state wide effort to decide if all Co. Surveyors should be appointed or elected and since the Co. Board took no action at that time, it will be on the ballot.

Motion by Eggleston, 2nd Bryner, to approve Res. 43-2020, (NE Rev Stat.-32-525) to direct the County Clerk to place on the General Election Ballot the question of the Custer County Surveyor to remain an elected office or to be appointed by the Custer County Board of Supervisors. Roll call vote. Ayes-all

After reviewing the agreement for EPC with Region 3, BHS, it was decided to change locations. Motion by Kleeb, 2nd Bryner, to sign a Letter of Agreement between Custer County and Reg 3, BHS to change EPC to Mary Lanning Hospital, Aug 21, 2020 to June 30, 2022. Roll call vote. Ayes-all

D. Downey, Merna Village rep., Merna Township board, and Co. Hwy Supt, were all present to Discuss the road from Trotters to the east to the curve on road to Victoria Springs. It was decided that half of this road belongs to the Village of Merna and half to Custer County.



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Motion by Bryner, 2nd Myers, to have an agreement with Village of Merna and Custer County, for fix this road and be shared 50/50 from Andrew's street east to ½ way thru Blk 1,2nd Addition. Half is owned by Custer County and half is owned by Village of Merna. East of that is Township & Village. Roll call vote. Ayes -all

Doug Stanton and Harlan Welch from District 8 Probation were present to discuss with the Co. Supervisors issue that have taken place at the Judicial Center with building access. An agreement was made to use the South door for after hours and notify the Co. Attorney's office each time of a meeting.
