Chairman Fox read the letter from NIRMA. Motion by Stunkel, 2nd Olson, to approve Res. #63-2020 Amendment and Addendum to the NIRMA/NIRMA II Intergovernmental Interlocal Agreement, to commit another three years, July 1, 2021-2024. Roll call vote. Ayes-all

Discussion was on the Cash in Lieu program that Custer County offers, renewal for 2021 will need completed.

COVID 19 sick pay and guidelines to follow were reviewed and it will be on the next agenda.

Motion by Stunkel, 2nd Kleeb, to sign the Certification of the Cost Allocation Plan thru year end June 30, 2019. Roll call vote. Ayes-all



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Motion by Olson, 2nd Myers, to authorize Chairman Fox to sign to request for reimbursement from HHS for indirect costs. Roll call vote. Ayes-all

Deputy Treasurer Moran presented the 2019 Distress Warrant report to the Custer Co. Board of Supervisors.

Motion by Kleeb, 2nd Olson, to close the bids @11:00 a.m. for a Sheriff Patrol Vehicle. Roll call vote. Ayes-all

Two bids were opened: Sandhills Motors- 2021 Ram w/trade \$27,000.00; Gateway Motors-2021 Chev Silverado w/trade and GM bid assistance \$19,820.00.

Osmond requests that if the pickup is not traded in, that the entity that gets it will pay that trade value to seller.
