Motion Myers, 2nd Eggleston, to direct the Custer County Treasurer Bryant to make the Nov. 15, 2020, Building Bond interest payment of \$14155.00, agent fee \$200.00, total payment of \$14,355.00. Roll call vote. Ayes-all

Motion by Kleeb, 2nd Olson, to recess as the **Board of Equalization** and reconvene as the Co. Board at 9:18 a.m. Roll call vote. Ayes-all

Vice Chairman Olson reviewed the OOR contracts received for bids that were opened 9-30-2020. Motion by Eggleston, 2nd Myers, to authorize Vice Chair Olson to sign the CNEDD-CDBG Repurposed Funds-OOR Contract, CDS Inspections & Beyond Service/Consultant Agreement for Housing Mgt. Services, and CDS Inspections & Beyond Service/Consultant Agreement for Lead-Based Paint Specialized Services. Roll call vote. Ayes-all



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Sheriff Osmond reported on their canine drug dogs and having enough donations to purchase a new one to replace one. This community really supports this project.

Vice Chairman Olson read Res. 69R-2020 on Road #755 & #1146. Motion by Bryner, 2nd Stunkel, to approve Res. #69R-2020, to declare VACATED-Roads #755 & #1146, Petition #3411. Roll call vote. Ayes-all

The Aflac letter was reviewed again and the Board members agreed to direct Att. Bowers to write letter.

Motion by Myers, 2nd Eggleston, to Open a Public Hearing at 10:15 a.m. on Relocation of Rd. #857. Roll call vote. Ayes-all

Vice Chairman Olson asked for anyone that was in favor of relocation to speak. A. Unruh would like road relocated but at this time he has no extra money to add for expenses. No others spoke.

R. Maxwell, Custer Twp. expressed that at least 12,000 would need to come from Custer Twp. and they did not have these kinds of funds available.

M. Eggleston reported on Petition not being filled out correctly but both parties waived this and wanted to negotiate, so Unruh, Custer Twp., Eggleston all met and no one wanted to pay for relocation costs.

Motion by Eggleston, 2nd Myers to close the Public Hearing on Relocation of Road #857 at 10:40 a.m.

Motion by Eggleston, 2nd Myers, to deny the Relocation, Petition #3419 on Road #857. Roll call vote. Ayes-all

Vice Chairman Olson read Res. 68R-2020. Motion by Eggleston, 2nd Myers, to approve by Res. #68R-2020, to declare VACATED-Road #857, Petition #3418, effective Jan 1, 2021, and Custer County will give up any r-o-w along said road, and land reverts back to adjacent land owners. Roll call vote. Ayes-all
