A letter from Robert Beran/Dana Cole, was read for preparing the FY21-22 budget. Motion by Bryner, 2nd Longmore, to approve the Letter of Engagement for Robert Beran/Dana Cole to prepare Custer County Budget for the FY2021-22, for \$5190.00 plus \$275.00 for mileage. Co. Clerk Gracey reported to the Co. Board of Supervisors that the Final Audit report for FY ending June 30, 2020, has been received and is filed in the Clerk's office. Publication notice was in the Feb 4th, 2021, Custer Co. Chief, to let the public know that the audit is on file and open to the public.

Motion by Olson, 2nd Kleeb, to Open a Public Hearing at 10:00 a.m on the Custer County Hwy. One and Six Year Program Plan. Roll call vote. Ayes-all

Chris Jacobsen and Nick Olson, reviewed the plan to continue grinding on some roads, hot mix, overlay, and bridges. The Co. Board was informed on numerous other issues to be completed.

Motion by Stunkel, 2nd Myers, to approve Resolution #8R-2021, Adoption & Approval of the Annual One and Six Year Plan for Custer County Highway, without any change. Roll call vote. Ayes-all

Jacobsen reported on the Fracture Critical Bridge Program changes. Jacobsen has always done the bridge inspections but now he will not be able to, so the entity's/municipalities that have bridges will have the responsibility and expense of inspecting their own bridges. Jacobsen has notified them of these inspection changes.

Amy Oxford, Clerk Dist. Court, discussed the LB102 changes for the Clerk of the District Court. If this office becomes vacant or an incumbent does not file for reelection, this gives the County Board the option of eliminating this office. After much discussion and if this happens the County loses all control but still gets billed from the State, the Co. Board directed Co. Attorney Bowers to compose a letter in opposition of LB102.

Bob Westbrook, was present to discuss a sound system for the supervisor room and got the Co. Boards opinion on what was needed. He will get a quote to the Co. Clerk.
