April 27, 2021

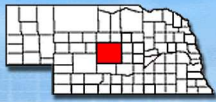

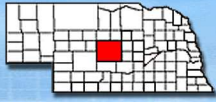
Co. Treasurer Bryant, reported on the American Rescue Act Plan, money to be received for COVID expenses. A new bank account with interest bearing needs to be opened.

Motion by Olson, 2<sup>nd</sup> Longmore, to approve Res. #15-2021, creating a new Fund #2580 COVID American Rescue Plan Fund to receive and distribute this money, and establish a new interest-bearing depository account. Roll call vote. Ayes-all

The Co. Board discussed the Disaster loans to the Townships and extension terms. They directed the Co. Attorney to draft a resolution for the next regular meeting.

Motion by Kleeb, 2<sup>nd</sup> Longmore, to appoint to the Loup Basin Resource, Conservation and Development Council board, as representative Kelly Flynn and alternate representative Doug Stunkel. Roll call vote. Ayes-all

A letter from the NE Auditor of Public Accounts was read by Chairman Fox and noted that they can do the Single Audit also needed for Custer County.



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Motion by Longmore, 2<sup>nd</sup> Olson, to approve NE Auditor of Public Accounts to conduct the Custer County Audit, a 3 yr. agreement for 2021, 2022, 2023. Roll call vote. Ayes-all

Chairman Fox read and reviewed the Great Plain Comm. contract for the next 5 years. After discussion on 3 or 5 years, it was a motion by Longmore, 2<sup>nd</sup> Bryner, to table until next meeting. Roll call vote. Ayes-all

Motion by Longmore, 2<sup>nd</sup> Bryner, to approve an application for Nebraska Central Telephone Co, to go under r-o-w with fiber optic cable, east and north of Ansley, S10,T15,R18. Roll call vote. Ayes-all

Chairman Fox read the Road Study from the Hwy Supt on Road #1519. Motion by Longmore, 2<sup>nd</sup> Bryner, to approve Res. #14R-2021, to accept the Rd Study and set a hearing date of May 25 for Rd. #1519, Pet. #3421. E. Custer Twp. Roll call vote. Ayes-all

T. Knott and residents on the Sumner Road were asking the plans for their road and the time frame that it might be completed. The Chairman stated that the One & Six Year Hwy. Plan was approved in February and this Sumner Road is planned to have the first two miles oiled by 2022, the remainder will be later. The dust on the road was a concern also and there are a couple of things but they are also expensive.

Motion by Myers, 2<sup>nd</sup> Longmore, to go into Executive session to discuss pending litigation, it being necessary for the protection of the public interest, or needless injury to the reputation of an individual, for the purpose of discussing strategy regarding pending litigation. Roll call vote. Ayes-all

Chairman Fox repeated the motion is to go into executive session at 11:26 a.m., it being necessary for the protection of the public interest, or for the prevention of needless injury to the reputation of an individual, or for the purpose of discussing strategy regarding pending litigation.

Chairman Fox called the Co. Board out of executive session at 11:54 a.m. No decisions were made.
