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Motion by Kleeb, 2nd Stunkel, to approve the April monthly fee reports for the Clerk, Reg. of Deeds, Clerk District Court, Co. Sheriff, and Recycling. Roll call vote. Ayes-all

Chairman Fox read and discussed the BC/BS insurance renewal. Motion by Stunkel, 2nd Bryner, to approve the BC/BS Subgroup Renewal application for FY2021-22, it was a 3.28% increase. Roll call vote. Ayes-all

The Co. Board discussed the Townships Disaster Loans and extending them one more year or with a good faith 25% payment by May 2022. Chairman Fox signed the letter of extension and the townships will need minutes and signed notes into the Clerk's office by May 21, 2021, for the extension.

Motion by Longmore, 2nd Bryner, to approve the NE Dept of Ag, Noxious Weed Report for 2020 as presented by Tim Conover, Weed Supt. Roll call vote. Ayes-all

The Co. Board discussed and reviewed the telephone contract and the internet speed. Motion by Longmore, 2nd Olson, to table until the next regular Board meeting. Roll call vote. Ayes-all

M. Rempe spoke on being reelected to the NRIN board and he is in agreement. Motion by Olson, 2nd Longmore, to vote the 2021 Ballot for Election to the NRIN Board and vote for Mark Rempe. Roll call vote. Ayes-all

Chairman Fox read Petition #3422, to vacate road #1128 and #1679 in Arnold Township. Motion by Olson, 2nd Longmore to accept Petition #3422 and by Res. #16R-2021, direct the Hwy Supt to complete a road study on roads #1128 and #1679. Roll call vote. Ayes-all

Jacobsen and Olson reported on bridges being completed as part of the bridge match program. Motion by Olson, 2nd Myers, to approve Res. #17R-2021 for Certifying Proper Completion of Project for the County Bridge Matching Program Agr. #BL1821. Roll call vote. Ayes-all

Representative Kamler, for Adrian Smith -will call in next meeting.

Steve Bowers, Co. Attorney, and the Co. Board discussed and answered the questions on the 30x 30 land grab, many issues and concerns were reviewed. Through the Zoning Regulations and with Conditional Use Permits, it may be a way to keep track of easements, and they directed Bowers to draft a Resolution against the Ex. Order for the next regular board meeting.
