MINUTES OF THE CUSTER CO. BOARD OF SUPERVISOR

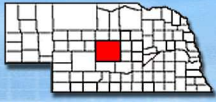
August 24, 2021

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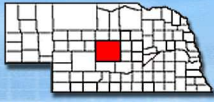

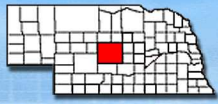

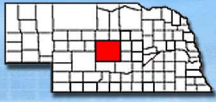

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Motion by Longmore, 2nd Kleeb, to approve Res. #30-2021, to approve the subdivisions Preliminary Levy Allocation requests for FY2021-22, with the exception of the Custer Co Ag Society which was adjusted from the requested allocation of \$177,735 to \$173,400.00. Roll call vote. Ayes-all (Fire District same as last year 0.015000)

Motion by Kleeb, 2nd Bryner, to adjourn as the Board of Equalization and reconvene as the County Board at **10:25 a.m.** Roll call vote. Ayes-all Nays-none

A call in session from Lutz & Co-Mark DeDiana and Sam Addy, Barry Fox, and the Co. Board was held at 10:30. Fox informed the Board that NACO/Jon Cannon, Ex Director has engaged Lutz & Co, CPA, who offers consulting/compliance procedures with the Coronavirus State and Local Fiscal Recovery Funds(SLFRF) as part of the American Rescue Plan Act

Motion by Longmore, 2nd Bryner, to sign a letter of engagement with Lutz & Co, for the purpose of consulting/filing/management of the SLFRF as part of the ARPA funds received by Custer County. Roll call vote. Ayes-all
